REGISTRATION FEE

£75.00 (*prep*)

£50.00 (*The Orchard pre-prep*)

DEPOSIT

(payable two terms prior to entry to all year groups except Nursery) **£350.00**

The balance of this deposit is refundable after the deduction of any outstanding charges following your final account.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Fees are payable on or before the first day of each term.

A term's notice, in writing, or a term's fees in lieu of notice, is required before the withdrawal of a pupil.

EXTRAS

Extras refers to activities that are additional to the school curriculum and are paid on an individual basis.

SCHOLARSHIPS

We offer scholarships for excellence in academic studies, art, music and sports, from Year 3. Scholarship Day for external candidates takes place in February each year. Internal scholarships are awarded at the end of Year 2 and Year 6.

BURSARIES and THE GREENWOOD AWARDS

Bursaries are awarded to girls in the pre-prep and prep school, whose parents demonstrate financial need.

The Greenwood Awards are unique to Knighton and are part of the school's charitable mission. These awards offer substantial funding to children joining in Years 3 and 4 with support continuing until Year 8.

All awards are made through a means tested application, at the absolute discretion of the school, as school funds allow and are reviewed annually.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Sibling discounts are also offered.

MOD DISCOUNTS

REMISSION OF FEES

Remission of fees cannot be made by the School in cases of absence through accident or illness. Our brokers offer various schemes - details of which are sent to all parents - which provide adequate cover if required.
